

Trip report from Southern Thailand 071199-231199

071199 Sunday:

-Cecilie Jacobsen and I left Tønsberg, Norway at 15.23 and headed for Gardemoen Airport, Oslo by train. We were airborne at 19.35. Landed in Stockholm an hour later and had to wait 3 h 30 min for Novair to take us to Phuket. At 23.55 the speaker told us that technical problems were at hand, and we had to wait three hours in addition to the previous three and a half. Hence, Novair sucks... NB All prices mentioned in the report counts for one person.

081199 Monday: 1

-Landed at Phuket Airport at 20.40. Had to wait an hour for passport control and luggage. A minivan to Phuket town costed 120 B, and we checked in at the dodgy Hotel Tharvan for 140 B. After listening to a Heavy/Thai concert and consuming some beer at a local pub, we retired and incidentally, we heard a Barn Owl in the backyard of our hotel.

091199 Tuesday: 2

-Bought a boat-ticket to Ko Phi Phi for 200 B. Looked at some birds in the eastern harbour, while we waited for the boat to set sail at 08.30:

-At the boat-trip to Ko Phi Phi it rained continuously, but still:

10 Christmas Frigatebird, 1 Brahminy Kite, 1 White-bellied Sea-Eagle, 1 Oriental Hobby, 5 Pomarine Skua, 2 Roseate Tern, 20 Black-naped Tern, 1 Whiskered Tern, 1 Pied Imperial Pigeon, 1 Drongo Cuckoo, 2 Sand Martin, 10 Pacific Swallow

-A short walk at the coastal trail resulted in:

101199 Wednesday: 3

-Did some birding from our Hotel Cabana veranda (1300 B is expensive, right?):

100 *frigate sp.*, 6 Brahminy Kite, 5 Shikra, 10 Crested Honey-Buzzard, 2 White-bellied Sea-Eagle, 25 Black-naped Tern, 10 Spotted Dove, 10 Dollarbird, 50 Pacific Swallow, 1 Scarlet-backed Flowerpecker, 10 Olive-backed Sunbird, 100 Common Myna

-Went to Krabi in the early afternoon and saw:

Swallow, 7 Richards Pipit (*rufulus/malayensis*), 2 Yellow-vented Bulbul, 1 Olive-winged Bulbul, 8 Ashy Drongo, 3 Large-billed Crow, 1 Puff-throated Babbler, 1 Black-throated Babbler, 1 Coppersmith Barbet, Tree Sparrow, Common Myna

111199 Thursday: 4

-Went to Ao Nang Beach to combine birding with other summer activities:

1 Chinese Pond Heron, 4 Brahminy Kite, 1 Crested Honey-Buzzard, 1 White-bellied Sea-Eagle, 1 Oriental Hobby, 1 Common Sandpiper, 2 Zebra Dove, 2 Spotted Dove, 1 Drongo Cuckoo, 2 Green-billed Malkoha, 1 White-throated Kingfisher, 2 Black-capped Kingfisher, 5 Asian Palm Swift, 100 *Swiftlet sp.*, 5 Dusky Crag Martin, 100 Pacific Swallow, 6 Bar-winged Flycatcher-Shrike, 1 Great Iora, 3 Lesser Green Leafbird, 1 Blue-winged Leafbird, 1 Stripe-throated Bulbul, 5 Arctic Warbler, 2 Common Tailorbird, 1 Blue Rock Thrush (*madoci*), 1 Blue Whistling Thrush, 1 Phillipine Glossy Starling, 50 Common Myna, 10 Olive-backed Sunbird, 2 Crimson Sunbird, 4 Orange-bellied Flowerpecker, 1 Scarlet-backed Flowerpecker, Tree Sparrow.

-Before sunset, large amounts of swifts gathered to feed on insects above Krabi:

4 Large-billed Crow, 1 Dollarbird, 500 Asian Palm Swift, 200 *Swiftlet sp.*, 1 Edible-nest Swiftlet, 1 Silver-rumped Swift.

121199 Friday: 5

Went out with Mr. Dai. First to the bay, then to the mangrove swamp (paid 150 B pr. hour):

131199 Saturday: 6

-Went to the beach all day:

2 Shikra, 3 Brahminy Kite, 1 White-breasted Waterhen, 4 Zebra Dove, 1 Green-billed Malkoha, 2 White-breasted Kingfisher, 2 Indian Roller, 1 Coppersmith Barbet, 10 Asian Palm Swift, 2 Pacific Swift, 10 Pacific Swallow, 20 Ashy Minivet, 5 Lesser Green Leafbird, 3 Black-headed Bulbul, 3 Stripe-throated Bulbul, 1 Olive-winged Bulbul, 1 Black Drongo, 1 Large-billed Crow, 1 Arctic Warbler, 6 Chestnut-headed Bee-eater, 3 Asian Brown Flycatcher, 2 Common Tailorbird, 2 Brown Shrike, 70 Common Myna, 30 Olive-backed Sunbird, 2 Orange-bellied Flowerpecker, 2 White-rumped Munia, Tree Sparrow

-Kwan's restaurant had the best food, cheapest beer (65 B for 0,65 litres) and they played

Jazz-music there.

141199 Sunday: 7

-Went to Khao Nor Cuchi (Khao Pra-Bang Khram) by 4x4 (we certainly needed it, many locals were stuck in the mud along the road). Arranged by the same as did mr. Dai for us. The ride costed 150 B. Stayed at a brand new bungalow resort. It was quite OK, but creepy with a lot of bugs on the floor, gekkos in the ceiling and two mice behind the wardrobe. The locals cooked excellent food and had an impressive *Varan bengalensis* as a daily dinner-guest. It was pretty tame, and we could handfeed it every day with fish and chicken after it appeared from the forest. We stayed there for three nights:

151199 Monday: 8

-Heavy rain ruined most of the day, but still:

2 Crested Honey-Buzzard, 1 Blyth's Hawk-Eagle, 1 Wallace's Hawk-Eagle, 1 Black-thighed Falconet, 1 Barred Eagle-Owl, 3 Hooded Pitta, 1 Banded Pitta, 5 *swiftlet sp.*, 100 Asian Palm Swift, 4 Grey Wagtail, 4 Ashy Minivet, 3 Black-headed Bulbul, 1 Stripe-throated Bulbul, 1 Yellow-vented Bulbul, 1 Red-eyed Bulbul, 1 Ochraceous Bulbul, 1 Black Drongo, 1 Bronzed Drongo, 1 Buff-breasted Babbler, 1 Moustached Babbler, 1 Brown Fulvetta, 2 Black-naped Monarch, 1 Little Spiderhunter, 10 Scarlet-backed Flowerpecker, 1 Pin-tailed Parrotfinch

-We were very satisfied with the two hawk-eagles, the owl and the pittas, but we were getting frustrated not to have recorded the Guerneys' Pitta yet.

161199 Tuesday: 9

-Up at 05.30. This turned out to be the best day during the entire trip:

- Up at 05.30 hoping to get another glimpse of the pitta. Another brilliant day in the forest: 1 Chinese Goshawk, 2 Chestnut-breasted Malkoha, 2 Dollarbird, 1 Red-crowned Barbet, 1 Guerneys' Pitta (only heard 06.30-07.30 at trail A), 10 Edible-nest Swiftlet, 5 Silver-

rumped Swift, 30 Barn Swallow, 2 Red-rumped Swallow, 20 Ashy Minivet, 2 Lesser Green Leafbird, 2 Streak-eared Bulbul, 1 Stripe-throated Bulbul, 5 Yellow-bellied Bulbul, 1 Buff-vented Bulbul, 1 Black Drongo, 2 Bronzed Drongo, 1 Brown Fulvetta, 1 Flyeater, 1 Arctic Warbler, 2 Eastern Crowned Warbler, 1 Lanceloated Warbler, 2 Common Tailorbird, 1 Oriental Magpie-Robin, 1 Eyebrowed Thrush, 1 Blue-and-white Flycatcher, 3 Black-naped Monarch, 4 Rufous-winged Flycatcher, 3 Asian Paradise Flycatcher, 2 Common Myna, 1 Grey-breasted Spiderhunter, 5 Little Spiderhunter, 3 Yellow-breasted Flowerpecker.

201199 Saturday: 13

- Got really drunk early at Rai Leh Beach and didnt see much, only 3 Blue Whistling Thrush and a Peregrine Falcon (*peregrinator*)

211199 Sunday: 14

-Went to Tae Loi. Last chance of getting Nordmanns` Greenshank, but it was obviuosly too early for the Krabi speciality.

221199 Monday: 15
