Glossy Ibis *Plegadis falcinellus* 1 Ras Mirbat 2.9, 13 Khor Ruri 2.9. Spoonbill *Platalea leucorodia* 11 Khor Ruri 2.9.

Bonelli's Eagle Hieraetus fasciatus

Recorded in singles or pairs at Wadi Hinna, Khor Ruri, Ayn Sahanawt and Ayn Hamran.

Unid Harrier *Circus macrourus/pygargus* 1 Khaysa 3.9.

Barbary Falcon *Falco* (peregrinus) pelegrinoides 1 adult Ras Janjali 3.9.

Arabian Red-legged Partidge *Alectoris melanocephala* 1 in the road to Wadi Hinna 2.9, several calling in the hills at Ayn Hamran 6.9.

Broad-billed Sandpiper *Limicola falcinellus* 2 Khor Setima 3.9.

Black-tailed Godwit *Limosa limosa* 4 Khor Ruri 2.9.

Pomarine Skua *Stercorarius pomarinus* 3 3.9.

Arctic Skua *Stercorarius parasiticus* 1 adult light phase 5.9.

White-cheeked Tern *Sterna repressa* 2 second-summer with Common Terns at Khor Taqa 5.9.

Bridled Tern *Sterna anathaetus antarctica* 2 2.9, 35 3.9, 4 4.9.

Common Noddy Anous stolidus

1 Ras Khaysa 3.9, 4, including a second-summer bird, Ras Janjali 4.9.

Chestnut-bellied Sandgrouse *Pterocles exustus erlangeri* 10 on the plain at Mirbat 3.9.

Bruce's Green Pigeon *Treron waalia* Singles at Wadi Hinna and Ayn Hamran.

Didric Cuckoo Chryssococcyx caprius

Fairly common in the mountains. Not as many calling as earlier in the summer.

Jacobin Cuckoo *Clamator jacobinus serratus*1 Ayn Hamran 6.9.
Grey-headed Kingfisher *Halcyon leucocephala semicerulea*Singles in the mountains.

Singing Bush Lark *Mirafra cantillans simplex* Common especially at Ayn Sahanowt.

Long-billed Pipit *Anthus similis arabicus* 2 Ayn Sahanawt 5.9.

South Arabian Wheatear Oenanthe (lugens) lugentoides

A pair at Ayn Sahanawt as usual.

Arabian Warbler *Sylvia leucomelana* Fairly common in the mountains.

Upcher's Warbler *Hippolais languida* 1 Ayn Sahanawt 5.9.

African Paradise Flycatcher *Terpsiphone viridis harterti* Singles at Wadi Hinna and Ayn Sahanawt.

Shining Sunbird *Nectarinia habessinica hellmayeri* Common in the mountains.

Palestine Sunbird *Nectarinia osea* Singles in the mountains.

White-breasted Whiteye *Zoosterops abessinicus arabs* Common in the mountains.

Black-headed Bush Shrike *Tchagra senegala percivali* Singles in the mountains, especially at Ayn Hamran.

Isabelline Shrike *Lanius isabellinus* Single migrants in wadis and mountains.

Fan-tailed Raven *Corvus rhipidurus* Common, especially around settlements.

Tristram's Grackle *Onychognathus tristramii* Common in mountains and on adjacent plains.

Ruppell's Weaver *Ploceus galbula* Common in mountains and Salalah.

African Silverbill *Eudice cantinans orientalis* Fairly common in Salalah and mountains.

African Rock Bunting *Emberiza tahapisi arabica* Common in mountains.
