

## Rajasthan, India

January 12<sup>th</sup> – February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2002

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We spent 3 weeks in Rajasthan in India combining birding, a total of 240 species seen, and holiday. We travelled by public buses and trains except for the first day when we hired a car and driver from Delhi to Bharatpur at a cost of 5 rupies per kilometre. Since we had to pay the driver for his return back to Delhi the total cost summed up to 2000 rupies. (1USD ≈ 47rupies). Obviously the most convenient way is to travel by car, but if you have time and patience it's OK to travel by buses and trains, just make sure to book your train tickets well in advance.

As travel guide we used Lonely Planet's Rajasthan Guide. The best information about birding sites is to be found in "A Birdwatchers' Guide to India" by K Kazmierczak and R Singh. For bird identification we used "Pocket Guide to the Birds of the Indian Subcontinent" by R Grimmet, C and T Inskipp.

Jan 12<sup>th</sup>: New Delhi to Bharatpur by car, afternoon birding outside the park. Stayed at the Sunbird Hotel, good dry land birding is found behind the hotel.

Jan 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>: Full days birding in Keoladeo Ghana National Park, we rented bicycles from our hotel.

Jan 15<sup>th</sup>: Daytrip by public bus to Agra and Taj Mahal. The bus takes about 1,5 hours one-way.

Jan 16<sup>th</sup>: Birding around the village Mallah outside the park boundary.

Jan 17<sup>th</sup>: Full day birding in the park.

Jan 18<sup>th</sup>: Train from Bharatpur to Sawai Madhopur where we stayed at the Ankur Resort. Afternoon visit to Ranthambore fort.

Jan 19<sup>th</sup>: Morning trip by jeep to Ranthambore N.P. Afternoon spent around Tiger Den Hotel.

Jan 20<sup>th</sup>: Morning trip by jeep to Soorwal Lake and a second visit to the park in the afternoon.

Jan 21<sup>st</sup>: Train from Sawai Madhopur to Jaipur.

Jan 22<sup>nd</sup>: Sightseeing in Jaipur and then we took the overnight train to Udaipur.

Jan 23<sup>rd</sup>: Arrival in Udaipur at 10am. Found some birds at Sajjan Niwas Gardens.

Jan 24<sup>th</sup>: Auto-rickshaw to Tiger Lake.

Jan 25<sup>th</sup>: Public bus to Jaisamand Wildlife Sanctuary.

Jan 26<sup>th</sup>: Day spent in Udaipur.

Jan 27<sup>th</sup>: Udaipur to Pushkar by bus.

Jan 28<sup>th</sup>: Birding just north of Pushkar in the acacia forest.

Jan 29<sup>th</sup>: Halfway to Sonkhaliya by rented jeep with driver.

Jan 30<sup>th</sup>: Day spent in Pushkar.

Jan 31<sup>st</sup>: Morning spent just north of Pushkar in the acacia forest. Afternoon train to Delhi.

Feb 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>: Days spent in New Delhi

Feb 3<sup>rd</sup>: Early morning flight New Delhi via Amsterdam to Stockholm.

## Site descriptions:

### Bharatpur

A well-known site for most birders. There wasn't much water this year but many birds anyway. Inside Keoladeo Ghana NP some of the better birds were Dusky Eagle Owl, Marshall's Iora, Black Bittern, Long-billed Dowitcher, Brook's Leafwarbler and Black Francolin. To reach the village Mallah go past the entrance to the park for about 1 kilometre and take the first road to the left following the park boundary wall. We biked around this area and found both Brown Shrike and Singing Bushlark. In the dry land behind our hotel we ran into one Yellow-wattled Lapwing.

### Ranthambore

All birding inside the park has to be made by "tiger safari jeeps" which makes birding a bit difficult, so we concentrated on finding tiger, which we did on our second attempt. A good place to see Brown Rock-Chat is at Ranthambore Fort and we found Brown Crake along the entrance road. Semi-desert areas around the Tiger Den Hotel held some good species such as Yellow-wattled Lapwing, Desert Wheatear and Rufous-fronted Prinia. A pleasant surprise was Soorwal Lake, which held Indian Skimmer, Great Thick-knee and Rufous-tailed Shrike. We organized a jeep through our hotel.

### Udaipur

The local bus to Jaisamand Wildlife Sanctuary takes 1,5 hours. Ask specifically to be dropped at the Wildlife Sanctuary and not at the turn to the resort (the sanctuary entrance is 2 kilometres before the turn to the resort). The place is dry and rocky with acacia scrub. We looked for White-naped Tit but scored none. New birds for the trip were Long-billed Pipit and Tickell's Blue Flycatcher. Tiger Lake is easily reached from Udaipur by auto-rickshaw and a few hours spent here can produce some good species such as Variable Wheatear (ssp *picata* and ssp *ophistoleuca*), Sulphur-bellied Warbler and Indian Bushlark.

### Pushkar

A good area of acacia is found about one kilometre north of Pushkar along the road to Jaipur/Kishangar. The area is approximately one square kilometre in size and is situated between two mountain ridges. It's fairly easy to find birds here since there is no undergrowth and you can easily follow the birds. We were lucky to find one White-naped Tit on two occasions and we also had one female White-bellied Minivet, two Spotted Creepers, Variable Wheatear (ssp *ophistoleuca*) and both Brook's- and Tickell's Leafwarbler.

An afternoon walk up to the Savitri Temple, situated on top of a mountain south of town, produced 3 adult and 5 juvenile Rock Bushquails, Jungle Prinia and 2

House Buntings. Below the hill is a sewage pond, which held some ducks and waders.

During our stay in Pushkar we made a half daytrip to Sonkhaliya Closed Area 40 kilometres southeast of Ajmer. Arrangements should be made through the Forest Department in Ajmer in advance. Their office is not far from the main bus terminal in Ajmer and everything went extremely smooth and fast once we found the department. We hired a jeep and driver in Pushkar. You need a jeep to drive around in the area, as the roads aren't good. On the arrival at Sonkhaliya we were met by a forest guard (where is the forest?) who guided us and another group of birdwatchers. Half a day was a bit short to search the area thoroughly but at least we saw 3 flying Indian Bustards. More time here could produce Indian Courser.
