Short Report from a trip to Israel and Jordan 28 Nov - 5 Dec 2004

We travelled by regular flight (KLM and ElAl) since chartertours are no longer available. Arrived late Sunday 28 Nov at Eilat Airport. The weather was fairly warm and sunny most days. Cold nights. The wind was mostly from the east and quite strong. We rented a B-car from Avis at Eilat and another B-car from AVIS at Aqaba.

Main target species; Verraux's Eagle, Oriental Skylark, Long-billed Pipit, Arabian Warbler and Syrian Serin.

Itinerary:

29 Nov Visit to Eilat area, Km 19 and 20, Yotvata.
30 Nov Aqaba, Wadi Rum and night at luxurious hotel Sofitel south of Petra.
1 Dec Petra, Dana, Barra Forest and night at simple hotel in Ma´an.
2 Dec Wadi Rum again, Disi and Aqaba beach. Evening back to Eilat.
3 Dec Kibbutz Lotan, where we picked up Eran Banker, Shizzafon, Km 49
4 Dec Mizpe Ramon, Shizzafon, Yotvata, Km 19 and 20 (again with Eran)
5 Dec Early morning plane from Eilat-TelAviv-Amsterdam-Gothenburg

Remarks:

Invasion of Locusts (grasshoppers) observed in Eilat area, Yotvata, Wadi Dana and around Kibbutz Lotan. Millions of locusts at the two last places, filling the air! Extraordinary!

Wadi Rum did not produce Verraux`x Eagle, maybe because of human climbers now using the steep rock (600 meters!) behind the resthouse?

Barra Forest in Jordan, a well known breeding place for Syrian Serin, but probably the birds disperse in winter.
