Diary with trip report and localities visited

Wednesday 12/7 – Friday 14/7 The flight from Milano to Sao Paolo was cancelled!! Varig is in big economic trouble. This would follow us throughout the whole trip. In panic, we had to change plane it the very last minute leaving 1½ day earlier than planned! Left home at 21,30 wednesday evening fore a night drive to Stockholm, left at 06,20 thursday morning to Miami (!) via Frankfurt. Arrived at Miami, had to wait 5 hours and then of to Mexico City! Another Looong wait this time inside the plane out at the taxi-strip. 4 hours later on to Belem at the Atlantic coast. By now all sense of timing and night-or-day was gone. Refueled at Belem and set of at the last flight to Sao Paolo. Arrived finally at 19,00 local time after 55 hours traveling. Much to our surprise the luggage did show up after some palaver with Varig. Our return tickets are valid but there is no flight! We are promised information when coming back to Sao Paolo. The very nice Mr. Edson Endrigo was patient waiting and bid us welcome. Left the airport approx. 20,00 and checked in at Hotel Simon, alt 1080 m 23,30 at night.

**Saturday 15/7**. Set out at 06,30 at Hotel Simon patio. Finally the birding takes off!! New and beautiful birds are abundant at the feeders and in the trees in the garden. This mountainous forest at 1080 alt. was very productive. Walking parts of Tres Pico Trail and Edson show extremely good skill in guiding. Good views good bird good guide and the disaster to get here were forgotten! Spend the afternoon at lower trail, still productive and ended this good day at Normas garden where we had unbelievable view and numbers of hummingbirds and tanagers. Cold morning, most sunny, top-temp today +20°C.

**Sunday 16**/7. Early out of bed at 03,30 to the higher parts of Itatiaia NP 1,5 h from Hotel Simon. We reached the Cloudforest in prime time when bird activities are at a peak. Singing Black-and-gold Cotinga is easy to hear nut hard work and bushtrashing is needed to se it Eventually everyone get good views. The araucaria forest was spectacular and

Araucaria Tit-Spinetail one of the highlights. Spend late afternoon in farmlands N of Itatiaia city and the evening at a marsh on the northern parts of Itatiaia city. At night another pleasant species-list led by Edson and ends the Itatiaia NP visit with a good meal at the hotel.

**Monday 17/7**. Rise but did not shine at 02,30. No info about the return trip. Flight to Campo Grande 09,45, Widstrand, the tripleader check briefly about info of return tickets but none. New promises that it will be answers when coming back to Campo Grande. Fairly fast transit to taxi-airplanes. The 4-seated Cessnas took us out to Fz San Francisco. Arrived about 14,30, hanged around, photographed, some wrote postcard until dinner. After this the

best trips ever started. Spotlighting from the open Jeep called Jaguaretê. A fast and skill girl handled the spotlight high up at the jeep and this arrangement allowed everyone to see the animal well.

Not more than 15 minutes after the start one Man Wolf was seen and it was completely unshy of the light. It kept itself busy in hunting the fruits that is its basic food supply. The tour continues just a few 100 meters when our lightmaster finds a Ozelot hunting mice just 10 meters from us!!!! Marvellous views of this

Barn Owls, 10 000 caimans and, nearly forgot, The JAGUAR, a powerful female digesting its supper! Loads of images in the head when trying to get some sleep.

**Tuesday 18/7**. up at 05,30. Another jeeptour also productive and a long boardwalk through the marshes in the morning. Birded around until 11,00, lunch at Fz San Francisco and a 20 min. flight to Fz Barra Mansa on the shore of Rio Negro. Siesta and then a boat trip upstream in search of Giant Otter. Neotropical Otter made my heart beat faster until I realized that it was small. Anyway a nice animal. Boats are not the best when birding but Bare-faced- Currasows and Boatbilled Heron is seen. Above +35°C.

**Wednesday 19/7** Breakfast at 05,30 boats downstream. Chilly morning and of course low activity of the birds. When the sun starts to warm the birds start to sing. There had been good with a guide here, which we didn't have. 1,5 h later we saw a biggish animal further downstream! Vi scanned intensive and soon a GIANT OTTER male shown up, approach raised in the water to check us out and then quickly disappears down the river. Good Luck. We pulled the boats upon land and did some birding by foot which shown to be much better then bird by boat. In 15 minutes another 10 species is seen among them very good views of Mato Grosso Antbird. While trying to call the fellow tripmembers another 4 Giant Otters coming swing and whistling very close to me and Kurt. Close up views, not bad at all. Back to Fz Barra Mansa lunch and siesta. Anna and Anders goes for a canoe-trip. In the afternoon we enters a tractor wagon and goes nightshining with spotlights. Howler monkeys, Coatis, Crabeating foxes and loads of nightjars.

Dinner at late night. Very unpleasant order upon giving tip. A huge amount is demanded by the swedish co-tripleader that was very disturbing and brought a grey cast to the visit. This was to be shown at all Fazendas in Pantanal. It felt more or less like we should pay extra to keep their friends in a good mode until next visit...... Above +35°C.

**Thursday 20**/7 Breakfast at 05,00 and of to Fz Baia das Pedras at 05,30 in four pickups/jeeps. Very bad planning though we just doing transportation in the prime birding time and rushes through good habitat and nice forest. The only short birding stops are when any other car than the tourleaders is first in line and we spot a few birds. Only longer stop is when Staffan want to take photographs of the sunrise. Everyone was thinking there should be a real nice place worth hurrying to but to our surprise we did hurry to lunch and siesta. What a disappointment!! Fz Baia das Pedras was a nice place but *expensive*. Scary 15 Real for a capirihina! Anna, Anna and Anders went horseriding at 15,00 when the others birding the surroundings by foot. Anna was on a horseback 2nd time in her life that was a courageous thing of her to do. Lots of Macaws today. Above +35°C.

Friday 21/7

Early morning birding in the garden was hot with Cream-backed Woodpecker and Great Rufous Woodcreeper. Entered a small lorry and birded from the loading

platform. Not to bad. Continued deeper into Pantanal about 3 hours and produce some good birds. Lunch and siesta for some, Helge and Anders go birding in clandestinely\* in the garden and surroundings. Good views of Yellow-faced Amazon and Lesser yellowheaded vultures. Another gamedrive again pays of as we see a Tapir with calf in the most beautiful evening light slow walking on a riparian bank. Dinner and a late gamedrive give 2 common Potoos and Giant Anteater with a cub at her back. Above +35°C.

**Saturday 22/7**. Set out at 06,00 in the surroundings to the Main buildings. At 09,00 off to Fz Mangabal which is another 2,5 h jeepdrive deeper into Pantanal wilderness. Nice Place not at all that expensive as Fz Baia dos Pedros. Lots of Redlegged Seriemas but no Puma. Nice dinner and gamedrive for Puma. No puma but lots of nightjars. Anders caught a Pauraque and showing it close-up to everyone. Above +30°C.

**Sunday 23**/7. Morning as usual and off at 06,00. This time just a short drive and finally some birding by foot. Immediately we find lots of nice birds. However some of the best views today were to be found in the garden just in front of the kitchen; the female cook took good care of animals and had perfect knowledge of where and when to look. She firmly

shows us Ferruginous Pygmy-Owl who was cooperative as photographer's model. Furthermore she knew where the Tamandua slept during the day. Gamedrive after a nice dinner reveals 100's of nightjars and one Scissor-tailed Nightjar caught and shown. Top-temp today +42°C

#### Monday 24/7.

Another horseride fore half of us the rest birded the surroundings by foot. From 11,00 mostly a long day of transportation Cessna to Campo Grande. Still no Return tickets home and no info whatsoever. Arrived at Campo Grande 14,30 didn't do any birding, haven't got a chance. Spend all afternoon evening in the town, waiting for partydinner to celebrate the Pantanal trip. Walks 2 hours in the town, sending some E-mail from a




cheap Internetcafe. Doing nothing and less until partytime at a BBQ restaurant. Loads of meat ( and wine) and a real heady Caprihinia. Top-temp today +38°C

**Tuesday 25**/7. Morning flight to Cuiba, met our guide from Pantanal Bird Club, Fabiano, bus to Chadapa do Guimarães NP. Lunch downtown at Fellis. Check in at Posada de Chapada, good place to stay. Starts birding at the Great rift and the Waterfall. Crested Blacktyrant, Bisqutate swift (after some anxiety how to separate them from white-collared) among others. Not that hot today.

**Wednesday 26**/7 Breakfast at the Posada at 05,00. Birds Vale de Sol 06,15-11,00. Almost first bird when out of the bus was Horned Sungem!! This is a real dry bushy Cerrado and of course all the Cerrado special birds with Chapada Flycatcher and Campo Flycatcher on top. Getting hot at noon. Lunch and siesta until 15,00 when the more forested parts are visited. We start at Jamaca river Valley road where Lettered Araçari is the best bird. Manakins and Flycatcher also giving good views. Top-temp today +38°C

**Thursday 27**/7 Chadapa do Guimarães NP, Agua Fria road. Another Cerrado-spot with lots of birds and Fabiano shows his skills. Birds on at the hooter and hotter road. Good species and quite a lot of birds. After Lunch and siesta to the forest at Mirante where manakins are very welcome views. Late walk to a ravine where Bandtailed Nightjar and Barn owl resides. Again, dinner at Fellis. Top-temp today +42°C



**Friday 28/7** Got a telephone from home at 04,40 saying that there should be rebooked flights by Flygpoolen at Lufthansa. Birding come then. Agua Fria road in the first morning, yields Blue-tufted Starthroat, Rufouswinged Antwren among others. Takes the bus a 30 min. to Vale de Bençao. Hooded Tanager, Blue-crowned Motmot and Long-billed Starthroat as top birds. Leaves Chapada with bus saying goodbye to our nice and skilled guide Fabiano, who been showing us lots us good species, Arrivals Cuiba airport by a comfortable margin. However no tickets to be seen or picked up at Cuiba. Makes the bird observation-list at the café. Says goodbye to both trip leaders (though still having no flight tickets home), and to Donald and Lars who sets out to bird another 4 days at Manuas. Our flight to Sao Paolo is, as usual, late and we arrives Sao Paolo late. Donald and Lars went to Manaus, The tripleader lefts us to party in Campo Grande and the rest of us went to Sao Paolo in search of our flight tickets home. I had to do a lot of talking and walking in Sao Paolo airport but worthless anyway. Have to go back tomorrow. Have to spoil the morning birding at Ubatuba in search of tickets. Not good!

**Saturday 29/7.** Up 04,30. At the airport 05,00, talk to the Lufthansa people, and finally info worth something. There are valid bookings made by Flygpoolen. Lufthansa will fly us tomorrow but we have to get vouchers and new tickets from Varig. More easily said than done. This is the kind of situations you really need a tourleader. Well we didn't have one but manage to talk our way through with good help from Edson. Finally everyone got tickets and at 08,00 we set of to Ubatuba. Rain and rain but we put up with that and kept birding and spirit high! As result of this we saw real good birds like Buff-throated Purpletuft among others. More and even heavier rain in the afternoon. We visited Jonas Place, a marvellous man and even a more marvellous garden: LOAD and LOAD of hummers and tanagers. More than one full hour and not a single moment without Hummingbirds around my head! This made me really happy! Festive Coquettes is a real beauty and Saw-billed Hermit has great charm. Nightwalk yields howling Tawny-browed Owls. End-of-trip celebration dinner a pizzeria (!) was a good party, with excellent pizzas, nice Brazilian (!) wine and high team spirit. Mikael was a gentleman and treated all the wine. Top-temp today +20°C

**Sunday 30**/7. Up and packed leaving the hotel at 05,00 and birds the forest along the slopes close to the Atlantic. Edsons inveterate energy and very high birding skills keep producing birds in excess of two hours but soaking wet in the HEAVY rain, we are forced to take cover. We did that at Jonas Place where the Hummers, Longbilled Wren and beautiful observations is a very nice ending of this Brazilian Trip. Time to stop birding and go back to the hot summer in Sweden. Top-temp today +20°C in heavy rain all day. Midday flight to Frankfurt, transfer and flight to Gothenburg, Oslo and Stockholm respectively, everyone arrives in good order home late **Monday** morning 31/7.
