
## Tierra del Fuego, Argentina - a very brief trip report

We saw White-bellied Seedsnipe at Garibaldi Pass 9 mars 2006, just south of a small lake (54 40'50.1"S 067 52'06.2"W). This was on

our third attempt. Don't expect it to be easy. They are very well camoflaged and don't flush easily, but they *are* there! You'll see **Yellow-bridled finches** quite easily while you search. We saw **Andean Condors** here aswell.

The dump/abbatoir is at (54 47'43.3"S 068 15'26.2"W). Here you'll see **White-throated Caracara**.

We saw a **Magellanic Horned Owl** roosting in a tree at the pic-nic site in Tierra del Fuego NP at (54 49'59.3"S 068 33'40.9"W). **Rufous-chested Dotterel** were seen at (54 49'50.3"S 068 19'56.3"W)
