

# PANAMA BIRD TRIP 3-22 Feb 2017

Number of bird species recorded in the country: 969.

We recorded 586 bird species, 14 mammals, 7 reptiles and 2 frogs.

Major "dips" were Silvery-throated Jay, Sulphur-rumped Tanager and Sooty-faced Finch. The trip records have been uploaded to iGoTerrra.com and this trip report is available for download at Joerl Travels website; www.joerl.se/travelreports.html

Panama is almost 600 km wide from NW to SE, but the Panama Canal at the isthmus is only 77 km long. The population is 4 million inhabitants, by whom almost 50% live in the Panama City area (> 2 mill.) The currency is Balboa, but US \$ is widely accepted, as well as Visa/MasterCard.

## Itinerary and daily log - by Erling Jirle

#### 3 Feb 2017

Bengt-Eric and Anders left Öland at midnight and drove to Malmö, then train to Copenhagen Airport at 4:00, while Erling and Nils had a 45 min train trip from Lund to Copenhagen Airport. First a short flight to Frankfurt, then a 11-hour flight Frankfurt – Panama City, where we were picked up at the airport at 20:00 by a Toyota Minivan and installed at Radisson Golf & Resort Hotel at the Gamboa Road.

#### 4 Feb 2017 - Birding Day 1

After a nice breakfast at the hotel we met our guide for the trip, Euclides "Kilo" Campos, an excellent guide, who knew where to find the birds, all the calls, and he is also extremely good at spotting them in any habitat. The most common comment from Kilo was "look at the dot!" That's when he points out the bird with his strong green laser. We warmed up with 2 hours in the Metropolitan Park close to the hotel. This 265 ha reserve has an impressive bird list of 267 species. We saw the targets Panamanian Tyrannulet, Black-tailed Myiobius and Rosy Thrush-Tanager among many other species. The habitat is Caribbean slope wet forest. Then we walked Old Gamboa Road for 2 hours and saw our first Isthmian Wrens, a recent

Then we walked Old Gamboa Road for 2 hours and saw our first Isthmian Wrens, a recent split. We took a 2-hour lunch break at the hotel and visited Pipeline Road from 14:30 to 17:00. Pipeline Rd is especially good for antibrids despite being so close to a 2 mill. city. We only did the first kilometres of this road today.

#### 5 Feb 2017

We left the hotel before dusk and drove along the Pipeline Road as far as you can go with a minivan; to the junction at Canopy Lodge. We had breakfast there waiting for the sun to come up, then at 6.45 we walked the Juan Grande Trail, the lower part of Pipeline Road, down to Río la Seda bridge at km 4.9. Here we turned back at 9:30 and walked back to the minivan, reaching it at 12:00. Pipeline is a very good birding spot, you get close to many birds, even some of the elusive antbirds, and with some patience you even get some good photos. The forest is mixed secondary and old growth Caribbean slope wet forest.

Birds we saw here where Black-breasted Puffbird, Spotted Antbird, Streak-chested Antpitta, Grey Elaenia, Brown-capped Tyrannulet, Black-capped Pygmy Tyrant, Blue Cotinga, Russetwinged Schiffornis,

We had lunch in town and some siesta at the hotel, then went to Old Gamboa 15-17. The weather was cloudy/partly cloudy. Old Gamboa road is situated in the southernmost part of the large Soberania National Park, on the Caribbean slope.

#### 6 Feb 2017

After a nice big hotel breakfast, we left at 7:00 for Campo Chagres, a part of the big Chagres NP. In contrast to the sites visited the day before, this reserve is situated on the considerably drier Pacific slope. The birding here is easier, since the forest is less dense than Caribbean rainforest. My target species number one here was Pheasant Cuckoo, and we saw one just a few meters away and even got some nice photos. Bare-crowned Antbird was also seen. For lunch, we went to the city centre and visited a type of restaurant we were going to visit many times during the trip; a lunch buffet restaurant where you choose 3 among many different warm dishes, and then add potatoes, salad etc. and pay a fixed price. Fast and efficient and often quite tasty food.

Since we did very well on our target species the previous days we visited a place not planned in the itinerary before the trip. That was the huge mudflats in the Panama Bay at Old Panama City, were the Pacific Ocean at low tide expose large mudflats with huge amounts of waders, gulls, tern and herons. Lesser Black-backed Gull, Dunlins and several others are considered rare here, I doubt they are really that rare.

In the late afternoon, we birded Summit Pond and other places along the Old Gamboa Road for a third time. Old Gamboa Road runs through semidecidous Caribbean slope forest.

#### 7 Feb 2017

Today we left Panama City early. It takes over one hour to get out of the city, because of the heavy traffic. It often jams, especially at rush hour. They are also building a new metro line on pillars above the Pan-American highway which causes extra jam. We went eastwards along the Pan-American Highway, which starts in Alaska and ends at Darien Gap. The road becomes rather narrow, but has fairly good standard, and not that many potholes. We had breakfast along the road at a small cafeteria and then we birded Saint Francis Reserve first in the morning and then again 14:30–17:30. This reserve is a private forest reserve owned by an American, who has a big farm here. The forest covers an area of 1000 ha and the habitat is dry Pacific lowland forest. The trail up through the forest is wide but very steep. We got the targets Central American Pygmy Owl (good views), Scaly-breasted Hummingbird, Stripe-cheeked Woodpecker (a Panama endemic), Black Antshrike and Yellow-bellied Tyrannulet. The hotel this night and the night after returning from Darien Gap was Hotel Avicar in Torti. It has a nice garden and a good swimming pool. I spend some time there relaxing during the lunch break. They also have some hummer feeders, we got one target species on the feeders;

Snowy-bellied Hummingbird. The disadvantage of the hotel is that they don't provide Wi-Fi, very inconvenient at a well-known tourist hotel like this in a city.

#### 8 Feb 2017

After an early breakfast, we birded along the small Torti River. The rest of the day we made frequent stops along the Pan-American Highway and got many new trip species. It was easy birding here except when you try to see a calling antbird. Other birds where Grey-cheeked Nunlet and Spot-crowned Barbet.

We had both lunch and dinner at a restaurant in the town Metetí, and also stayed overnight at a simple hotel here. But it was equipped with good air-con and working wifi.

#### 9 Feb 2017

We did Pan-American Highway again in the morning from Metetí to Yaviza, where the road ends. This stretch of road is really a good birding spot, with many species, and fairly easy birding, today we saw 5 Black Oropendulas. To get further we entered a dug-out canoe with a powerful motor, a Yamaha 80 hp, and went along on Rio Chucunaque. The sun was very strong during mid day, some of us got very red. It took one hour to reach El Real at the south bank of the river. This is the entrance to Darien Gap. We were picked up by a 4WD pick-up, stopped for lunch at a small restaurant in El Real and then later were dropped off at the entrance road to Darien National Park. A horse took our luggage, we walked and birded the 3,5 km trail to the ranger station Rancho Frio where we were going to stay for two nights. In late afternoon we birded along one of the trails and saw Great Green Macaw. The short grass at Rancho Plastico unfortunately is home for big numbers of chiggers – we noticed that the day after when the ancles started to itch. The chiggers probably occur also elsewhere in the lowlands, but not so much up at Cerro Pirre.

#### **10 February 2017**

We started the morning with a short walk up to a Harpy Eagle nest with a pull at nest. Then we walked up along ridges and saw birds like Dull-mantled Antbird, Scaly-throated Leaftosser, Lemon-spectacled Tanager and at the top of a ridge we saw Viridian Dacnis. In the afternoon, we did two other trails and late afternoon we again visited the harpy eagle nest, and now an adult female was sitting at the nest, very impressive, and the first time we saw an adult. In the evening, we did an owl tour 19:00–19:45 and got Crested Owl and Choco Screech-Owl.

#### 11 Feb 2017

Today we started the tough hike up to Mount Pirre, in Spanish *Cerro Pirre*. This is an isolated mountain range in the Darien Gap, close to the border to Colombia. Due to the isolation, it harbours a number of endemic subspecies, and even some endemic species.

We started the walk at 06:30 and reached Rancho Plastico at 12:00 and at 500 m.a.s.l. after some good birding along the way, the major target we saw was Tody Motmot, Slaty-winged Foliage-gleaner and Wing-banded Antbird. Rancho Plastico is a camp on the mountain ridge about half-way up to the top and has big plastic tarpaulin under which our five porters put up our tents, one tent per person. They also had to carry a propane gas tube, all water, food and our bags with extra clothes etc. Now we got the diet for the coming days, making us slimmer; biscuits, marmalade, raisins and orange lemonade. We had a 2-hour siesta, then walked the ridge trail uphill and downhill from Rancho Plastico until 17:30. There are two viewpoints [Mirador] with good views of the mountains and the lowland, where we saw large flocks of migrating Turkey Vultures and also King Vultures passing by at close range. After the usual simple dinner and the checklist writing we went to bed already at 19:40, since there is not so

much to do once it gets dark. Not very good sleep due to snoring neighbours - but probably enough sleep anyway while staying 10 hours in the tent.

#### **12 February 2017**

Breakfast at 06:00, departure at 06:30. Today we had the steep climb up to Cerro Pirre Camp 1, at 1100 m.a.s.l. It was very steep at the beginning, then moderately steep, but then the last couple of hundred meters it was almost vertical, so you had to hold on to trunks and stones to be able to climb up. The backpack felt very heavy today, with 500 mm camera lens, camera, water and raingear. Our team has travelled a lot together in many countries, and similar camping hikes like this, i.e. in the Philippines and Venezuela, but this was one of the tougher. We saw a number of good birds on the way up – and as soon as we reached the top plateau at Cerro Pirre Camp 1 we saw a Pirre Warbler, one of the endemics. Other birds on the walk up was Dusky Leaftosser, Choco Tapaculo, Pirre Bush Tanager, Green-naped Tanager, and Varied Solitaire. I like the beautiful but a little sad song of solitaires. 12:30–16:00 we walked on the ridge trail about 2 kilometres. The trail was overgrown, and there is a very annoying grass with long, sharply pointed tips which gets stuck to your clothes and even the skin. The forest type is cloud forest - with lots of bromeliads, mosses and lichens. When it is cloudy it is difficult to observe bird parties passing through high up in the canopy. Good birds today were Pirre Hummingbird. The evenings up here at 1300 m are rather chilly, so after a rather simple dinner consisting of rice and chicken stew prepared by our cook Paco, and done with the list we went into our tents already at 19:00.

#### **13 February 2017**

Breakfast at 06:00, and off at 06:30. Today we walked furter on the ridge trail, about 4 kilometres, and almost reached Cerro Pirre Camp 2. Kilo had a machete today to clear the trail from the annoying grass and tree branches. Today we where lucky to see Beautiful Treerunner, a major target for Cerro Pirre. Other species were Black-eared Wood Quail and Russet-crowned Quail-Dove. It was foggy due to low cloads until 10:00, then it cleared up. We turned back at 11:00 at reached our camp at 14:30 and got coffe and relaxed in the strong sunshine. At 18:00 we were making the checklist when it started to rain, and during the dinner we had to take shelter under the plastic "presenningar". During the whole trip we were lucky with almost no rain during birdwatching hours.

#### **14 February 2017**

Today our porters and the cook where a bit slow due the chilly morning, but we where in no hurry, so at 7:30 we left the camp and walked slowly down the steep trail. Bengt-Eric is very slow downhill due to bad knees, but he made it. We reached Rancho Plastico after 3 hours and had lunch and a rest in the tents. 14:00–17.00 we birded the trail below Plastico, and finally, after a lot of playing the call the previous days, Kilo heard a Black-crowned Antpitta 50 meters below the trail. Not everybody in the team got to see it though, but the next morning another one was spotted near Plastico, so everybody finally could tick it. This is really a tricky species, they don't seem to respond to playback. Despite the name Antpitta it actually belong to the family Gnateaters. We also heard 3 Choco Tinamous in the late afternoon, and worked hard to see one, but they are extremely elusive. Tawny-faced Quail was also heard.

#### **15 February 2017**

Last night in tent on the trip! We walked down to Rancho Frio in two hours, where we could shower and have lunch. Then we walked one hour to the El Rey road. We got there 12:50, but the Jeep didn't come until 14:20, Kilo had tried to get it earlier than the pre-arranged time

14:00. But then we went to the river, Rio Chucunaque, and did the 45 minute boat trip to Yaviza, where we grabbed some cold beer. Finally, we drove 3 hours to Torti and the hotel with real beds and warm showers. A really good sleep here.

#### **16 February 2017**

Today we drove westwards on the Pan-American Highway, and made a stop at the Molo Bridge at 07:30. Then further west until the turn off up on a mountain road to the Nusagandi Reserve. There was a nice little hotel and restaurant. We walked a long trail with a local guide crossing small rivers and through dense vegetation in search for Sulphur-rumped Tanager – but unfortunately we failed to find it. We also walked along the main road and searched for it in vain.

In the afternoon we arrived at the domestic airport in Panama City, at Albrook, and took a 45 minute flight to the largest city in western Panama, David. We where picked up by a minivan, had dinner at a roadside buffet restaurant and arrived at the big Hotel XXXX, which had a nice garden with a small river crossing through.

#### **17 February 2017**

Now we were in the mountains in westernmost Panama, in the province Chiriquí. We left in early morning with the minivan to a mountain village, where a 4WD pickup was waiting for us. It took us up to the ranger station at 2600 m.a.s.l., Alto Respingo, which lies in the large Volcan Baru National Park. It was still dark when we arrived, so we spotted a Dusky Nightjar and Bare-shanked Screech Owl and had good looks on both. After breakfast in the mirador at the ranger station we walked down along the famous Quetzal Trail [Sendero Los Quetzales]. Here we saw the number one target on my personal target list – Wrenthrush. This odd species were formerly placed in its own family (Zeledoniidae). IOC categorize it as Incertae Sedis while HBW place it in family Parulidae. Recent research, however, indicates that this species appears not to form part of a monophyletic parulid family. So maybe in the future it will become a monoptypic family of its own again.

Other target species we saw were White-throated Mountaingem and Ochraceous Pewee. Spotted Wood Quail was heard. We returned to the ranger station and walked down the road to the mountain village, reaching it 15:00, where the minivan was waiting. After a rest at the hotel we then drove to a private property, Mishael's House. There was a young local guide, who shoed us Lesson's Motmot, Smoky-brown Woodpecker and Orange-collared Manakin. They also had hummingbird feeders, with White-necked Jacobin, two species of violetears, Garden Emerald, and Long-billed Starthroat but we couldn't spot any Charming Hummingbird.

#### **18 February 2017**

Volcan Lakes in the morning. This area belongs to a private coffe farm, Janson Coffee. We saw White-tailed Emerald, several species of spinetail, barbtail, and antwrens. We walked a forest road up to two lakes. Then we went to Cañon Macho de Monte which is a deep narrow canyon near Cuesta de Piedra. Here Kilo found a Charming Hummingbird for us. In late afternoon we arrived at the mountain resort Boquete Tree Trek and got installed in two very large and nice cabins, with on big room with beds and then one upper floor with more beds. The hotel had a big garden and surrounding forest where we saw 10 Resplendent Quetzals, but they flew quickly between the oak trees up the slope and I didn't get any good photo of this bird - one of my favourite species which I hadn't seen since a Costa Rica trip back in 1993. It was dissapointing that I didn't got close to any bird neither here during two days or at the Quetzal Trail in Baru NP. Other birds in the garden was Prong-billed Barbet,

#### **19 February 2017**

We walked trails and along the main road in the morning at Palo Seco reserve. Highlights were good views of a Costa Rican Pygmy Owl and a species high up on the wish-list: Snowcap!

We had a lunch-break at a roadside restaurant; Café Isabel. More roadside birding in the afternoon.

#### **20 February 2017**

We did a short stop along a main road where Kilo had a stake out for Veraguan Mango - and got it.

Quetzal Trail again in the morning. But this time we started at Alto Chiquero, the lowest part of the 8 km long trail. Birds we saw were Sulphur-winged Parakeet, Dark Pewee, Threewattled Bellbird,

Then 11 o'clock coffe at Sonia's Coffee Shop, at the coffe farm and Hotel Finca Lerida, with a big garden and hotel bungalows with nice views of several hummingbird species.

After lunch in Boquete we drove down to agricultural areas east of David, at La Barqueta Beach, close to the Pacific coast, where we saw some new species for the trip, like Blackbellied Whistling Duck and Lesser Yellow-headed Vulture.

In late afternoon, we flew from David to Panama City, then a two-hour drive westwards to a hotel in El Valle, in the Coclé province.

#### **21 February 2017**

In the morning we drove up to the reserve Cerro Gaital, where we walked several trails. Good birds here were Bronze-tailed Plumeleteer and Sepia-capped Flycatcher.

#### **22 February 2017**

We visited Cerro Gaital again, and this time we a White-tipped Sicklebill, feeding on a In the afternoon, we drove back to Panama City, making a small detour down to close to the Pacific Ocean at Malibu Ponds in Gorgona, where we saw a Ferruginous Pygmy Owl and a Pale-eyed Pygmy Tyrant.

We arrived at the International Airport in Panama City at 16:00 and said goodbye to Kilo and our driver and left for Frankfurt - Copenhagen.

Personally I got 60 lifers out of the trip list 586, so over 10% which was a bit better than expected. It was a nice trip with nice company – and no incidents.
