Highlights

- Penguin Island: Great experience to see all breeding terns and gulls, and best of all, after having given
 up: BS found a lone Little Penguin under a limestone overhang. Only moulting birds stay day-time on the
 island.
- Scenery at Cape Leeuwin with easy-found Rock Parrots and good seabird movements. Albatrosses and Shearwaters, although mostly at distance.
- First sightings of forest birds and parrots in newly burnt forest along Thompson Rd, Lake Muir. Rufous Treecreeper, Western Corella, Baudin's Black Cockatoo.
- "The Three" at Cheynes Beach: Noisy Scrubbird, Western Bristlebird, Western Whipbird.
- Hooded Dotterel at Bremer Bay.
- Singing Southern Scrub-robins at Quaalup Homestead.
- Extensive wilderness and scenery at Fitzgerald River National Park including skulkers Western Fieldwren and Shy Heathwren.
- The silhouette of Stirling Range and birding around the Retreat compounds with "Western" Shrike-tit, Australian Owlet-Nightjar, Restless Flycatcher, Elegant Parrot and Carnaby's Black Cockatoos.
- Biggest surprise of the trip: One sole Budgerigar at Stirling Range.
- Great birding activity at Dryandra after rain with White-eared Honeyeater, White-browed Babbler, "Western" Shrike-tit, Bush Stone-curlew, Painted Buttonquail and Jacky Winter.
- A calling Eastern Barn Owl showing well night-time at Ochre Walk, Dryandra.
- Copperback Quail-thrush at Mt Gibson Rd.
- Bourke's Parrots drinking at dusk at Jackson Well, Nallan Station.
- Walga Rock, west of Cue, almost as prominent as Ayers Rock. Mulga Parrot and Western Bowerbird.
- · A pair of Inland Dotterel!
- After a lot of effort: Two encounters with Western Quail-thrush west of Cue.
- Major Mitchell's Cockatoos at Paynes Find.
- And finally: Fairywrens! Wow!

General birding and strategy

In two weeks there is plenty of time seeing all south-western endemics and specialities. Most of the endemics and targets are widely distributed and shouldn't be a problem. We chose to add Nallan Station and the area around Cue along the Great Northern Highway in the trip to get a taste of the outback and a different set of species. Originally we had planned three nights at Nallan Station, but we did pretty well and wanted to cut the long drive back to Perth by changing to one night in Paynes Find on the return. At planning stage we considered adding Esperance and the Kalgoorlie-area, but that would have been many more miles driving and possibly not seeing so much more: Cape Barren Goose, maybe Gilbert's Whistler, Freckled Duck at Rowles Lagoon, and better chance of Copperback Quail-thrush.

Logistics

Car

Booked at Hertz. Smooth and easy pick up and return at the airport. We had a small SUV (Kia Sportage), suitable for 3 persons with bags and scopes. Besides a strange smell of sulphate during deceleration it worked fine. Throughout the trip we used offline maps from Google Maps, and sometimes/often relied on the smart

phone GPS. We drove around 4000 km(!).

Food

For breakfast we usually had some kind of yoghurt and muesli (could be a good idea to bring a small plastic dish and spoon). For lunch usually snacks/fruits/sandwich or we stopped at a diner. On most places we cooked our own dinners (no restaurants at Kalgan, Cheynes Beach, Quaalup, Stirling Range, Dryandra or Nallan Station). We stopped at grocery stores (not always easy to find) every second or third day.

Weather & timing

From a bit chilly early morning at Cape Leeuwin to fiery heat at Nallan Station mid-day. We had rain showers at Cape Leeuwin and heavy showers at Two Peoples Bay, and unstable at Cheynes Beach. Rain all day when driving from Stirling Range to Dryandra, and therefore excellent bird activity when we arrived Dryandra mid-day. A few light showers early morning at Mt Gibson Rd. Very hot from 8 AM at Cue — Nallan Station. Usually quite windy throughout. The best time to visit Western Australia is probably around September. At that time orchids are flowering in the south-west. There was decent song activity around Cheynes Beach at least. Mostly very quiet and seemingly empty in the outback (really tough birding). We saw a lot of breeding activity, both active feeding and small family groups with recently fledged juvenile birds. Seabirds are more plentiful and diverse during July and August. Nevertheless, a good time to escape Sweden...

- 26.11 Arrived Perth Airport 13:00. ATM. After car pick-up, lunch at Sandy's, Kelmscott, then drove to **Wungong Dam** south of Perth. Afternoon/evening birding there and at **Bungondore Park** at Admiral Rd. Night at Armadale.
- 27.11 Left Armadale at 05:00. Forrestdale Lake 05:30-06:45. Thomsons Lake 07:00-08:00. The Spectacles 08:10-08:40. Drove to Rockingham. First ferry to Penguin Island 09:00. Went back 11:10. After lunch (Domino's) went south of Mandurah via Thompson Rd and Mills Rd to Lake McLarty 15:00-16:30. Busselton 17:45-18:00. Arrived Augusta 19:30, the kitchen at the hotel closed at 20:00. Night at Augusta.
- 28.11 Left Augusta 05:00. **Cape Leeuwin** 05:20-10:00 (NOTE: The lighthouse and visitor centre doesn't open until 08:45 AM!). Drove via Nannup (lunch at nice Blackwood Café) to Thompson Rd, **Lake Muir** 14:30-16:15. Arrived Kalgan 18:15. Night at Kalgan.

- 29.11 **Cheynes Beach** 06:30-12:30. Via Lower Kalgan Bridge to Albany for lunch. **The Gap** 15:10-17:30. **Rushy Point Bird Hide** 18:00-18:15. Night at Kalgan.
- 30.11 Little Beach, Two Peoples Bay NR 05:00-08:00. Drive to Cheynes Beach. Road to Waychinicup Inlet 11:30-13:30. Cheynes Beach 15:30-18:30. Road to Waychinicup 20:30-21:00. Night at Cheynes Beach.






Map 1. South-western route. Day 1-10.

Map 3. Forrestdale Lake. S of Perth.




Map 5. The Spectacles. S of Perth.




Map 4. Thomsons Lake. S of Perth.




Map 6. Lake McLarty. S of Mandurah.




Map 7. Cheynes Beach. Some spots where we had any of "The Three".



Map 8. Waychinicup National Park.




Map 9. Quaalup Homestead, Fitzgerald River National Park.

Following IOC World Bird List 7.3 (July 2017) (<u>www.worldbirdnames.org</u>). In total: 206 species (all seen!), 10 species on The IUCN Red List for Threatened Species (2014.3). Subspecies notations are foremost literature-based.

1 Emu Dromaius n. novaehollandiae

1 Quiss Rd, Fitzgerald River (2/12), 1 Bluff Knoll Rd, Stirling Range (4/12), 2 Cue-Dalgaranga Rd (7/12). A few more roadside observation of birds in fenced areas among cattle probably non-wild, especially when driving from Augusta to Albany (28/11).

2 Black Swan Cygnus atratus

Seen on 8 days. Many hundreds in Perth lakes, most at Thomson Lake and Lake Joondelup, also 200+ at Bremer Bay (1/12).

3 Mute Swan Cygnus olor Introduced

10+ Northam Weir (5/12). According to Dolby & Clarke the only place in Australia that holds an argubly wild population of Mute Swan.

4 Australian Shelduck Tadorna tadornoides

Seen on 8 days. 100+ on 3 days. Found in most lakes.

5 Pink-eared Duck Malacorhynchus membranaceus






